

## VE6KQ HAM SHACK PHOTO

Below is a photo of the main operating position as of November 14, 2014.



Shown are 2 Yaesu FT101E's and a Realistic/Allied AX-190 receiver. The AX190 is sometimes used with both FT101E's when split operation is required. Also, neither FT101E's have an AM receive filter installed therefore I use the AX190 when I operate AM at this position. The microphones are Kenwood MC50's and work fine with the Yaesu transceivers although the connector pin-out is different. The speaker on the left is a Kenwood SP820, a match for my TS820 not shown.

On the top of the right FT101E is a frequency counter. Off to the right of the counter, not shown, is a Heathkit DX60B transmitter with a Drake R4B receiver I use on AM. The counter is used with this equipment.

The equipment on the table tends to change often. As you can tell there is no modern equipment here.
